Thinking of Visiting Mission Workers?

Practical Considerations:

- Keep the team small (2-3 people)
- Include people the mission workers already know
- Clarify purpose of trip ahead of time:
 - for encouragement
 - for participation in the ministries
 - to be a witness of the work
- Consider the timing of the trip as to not add additional stress or visit during a busy season
- Ask to participate in the day-to-day life and ministries of the workers to get a sense of what life is like for them
- Spend time with their kids as a way to show love
- Give them a date night or take them away for a few days



Good Questions to Ask:

- How is this term going for you?
- Is there a particular way we could better support you?
- How are your kids doing?
- How is your marriage?
- What kind of cultural stress are you experiencing?
- What has been encouraging to you lately?
- What is some discouragement you are facing?
- Are you experiencing burnout?
- What has God been teaching you lately?
- Do you have meaningful friendships here?
